### REGISTRATION DEADLINE

**May 31, 2006 - Last day to register without penalty**

Please remember to return your registration forms for the 2006-2007 soccer seasons **before May 31<sup>st</sup>**. **All forms received after May 31 will be subject to a \$30 late fee.** If you delay – you will pay!

Forms are available from all team managers, at the Oconomowoc Library, at the OSA Office, downloaded from the OSA website or NEW THIS YEAR – you can register on-line via the OSA website and pay by credit card.

### SELECT TRYOUTS

June 5 and 6 - Boys and Girls U11 to U14

June 12 - High School Girls U15 to U19

All tryouts will be held at Oconomowoc High School from 5:30 to 7:00pm. Check in begins at 5:00pm

Players must be present for **at least** one day but preferably both days of tryouts. **Contact the OSA office before June 1 if you are unable to attend both days.** Players are expected to be prepared and ready to train at 5:30pm sharp. Each player is expected to bring a suitable soccer ball, adequate water supply and dress ready to play. Shinguards are mandatory. 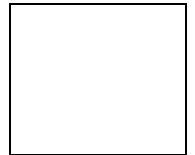
**Tournament** – Game schedules have been distributed to all team managers and coaches. If you don't know what time you're playing please ask your coach.
